Qualifications for *Distinguished* Alumni Hall of Fame Nominees

There are two nomination categories; they are as follows:

- **Alumni** – an alumnus must have graduated from SCHS a minimum of seven years prior to nomination.
- **Honorary** – a honorary candidate must have made a significant impact on SCHS. This category may include faculty, counselors and staff.

Suggested Criteria for Nominations – Distinguished Hall of Fame

1. Academic Excellence
2. Significant impact on SCHS
3. Honors/awards
4. Leadership and/or distinguished service
5. Community involvement/citizenship
6. Significant contributions to society
7. Graduated from SCHS (Distinguished Alumni nominee)

Qualifications for *Athletic* Alumni Hall of Fame Nominees

There are four nomination categories; they are as follows:

- **Athlete** – an athlete must have graduated from SCHS a minimum of seven years prior to nomination.
- **Coach/Administrator** – a coach or administrator must have retired from coaching or teaching at SCHS prior to nomination.
- **Team** – nominees may include certain SCHS athletic teams who accomplished undefeated seasons, championships, or the like.
- **Honorary** – a honorary candidate must have made significant impact on SCHS athletics and/or made a significant in regional, state, national, professional, or international levels of athletics. The honorary category may include faculty, counselors, athletic representatives or managers.

Suggested Criteria for Nominations – Athletic Hall of Fame

1. Leadership
2. Impact on SCHS athletic program
3. Honors/awards
4. School record holder
5. Community involvement/citizenship
6. Sportsmanship
7. Graduated from SCHS (Distinguished Athlete or Team nominee)
