Though we cannot determine what the public health conditions will look like or what the health officials will require for schools in August, our goal is to return to in-person instruction safely and "Start the School year Smart". We have been advised by public health officials to prepare for new protocols and modifications for our campus and have also been advised that we should anticipate the possibility of continuing with distance learning if Safer at Home orders are extended. We will be prepared for both.
